DOM PÉRIGNON RARITIES



Dom Pérignon Oenotheque Rose 1993 75cl

A vintage characterised by its precocity. Despite very average temperatures, the summer was remarkable both for its amount of sunshine and the drought which lasted until the harvest began. The wine is insolently brilliant and precise, with an almost youthful freshness and flavors of dates and pink grapefruit. On the nose, the first notes of red fruit are soon replaced by those of dried figs and spices. It has a tactile, powdery, silky presence, with a remarkably tense, sharp finish.

Dom Pérignon P2 1995 75cl

The year was notable for its exceptional summer: a fairly overcast spring meant that the vines flowered late but quickly. Once the sensation of power and structure is absorbed, the density of the fruit is thrown into relief on the mid-palate, and the pure finish, lively, incisive and mineral, is unveiled. On the nose, the overall impression is of smoked and toasted aromas with hints of biscuit, citrus zest and black cherry.

Dom Pérignon Rose P3 1988 Magnum 1.5L

After an astonishingly mild winter and early, rapid flowering of the vines the 1988 vintage was marked by a summer of alternating heavy rain and high temperatures.

The palate is sophisticated: tense, incisive and silky all at once, with a patina. The finish is firm and surprisingly fruity, with an unusual satiny note. The nose reveals itself in successive waves of dried flowers, orange peel, gingerbread, exotic tobacco and grilled aromas.
